A Domain Name is unique to you and only you. No one else can have the same domain name as it is this that directs your visitors to your site. I always recommend that you register your own domain name as the registered owner is the legal owner. To let someone else register on your behalf can mean you do not own your own domain!! By retaining control over your own domain you can renew it when required and in addition you will always have control to make any changes as and when required i.e. your personal details. Having said that web-sites4.eu can arrange for the registration of your domain name and this will be discussed with you prior to proceeding with your site. When deciding upon your domain name it is good if it can be as short as possible and the more memorable it is the better. Domain names end in extensions such as .co.uk, .com, .info etc and depending upon your requirements this can affect the cost. Prices for domains are very good now particularly if you go for .co.uk. There are various sites where you can purchase your domains and they will also allow you to search for your chosen name to see if it is still available. try www.123-reg.co.uk or www.uk2.net For any further information or help do not hesitate to get in touch.
